From small beginnings, our membership has blossomed to our current position where we boast a membership of over 80 societies, with some 35 schools now members, along with 30 Corporate members. Societies represented cover the length and breadth of New Zealand.

Administered from a small central office in Wellington, MTNZ is recognised both nationally and internationally for the contribution it has made to both fostering and increasing participation in the arts with our communities.
